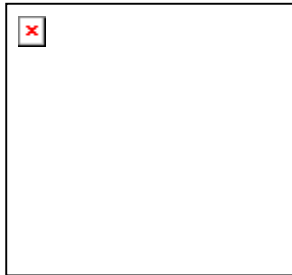

Hindustan Newsprint Limited invites bids from reputable manufacturers OR from their own subsidiary for the Upgradation of existing 100TPD Deinking Plant, at Hindustan Newsprint Ltd.

**1.0 Pre-qualification criteria(PQ Criteria)**

- 1.1 The Bidder shall be an internationally reputed manufacturer of De-inking Plant process line equipment with critical equipment such as Flotation cell, screens and Disperser, in their manufacturing range. The bids can be submitted by the manufacturer or by their own Subsidiary Company in the Pulp & Paper field. The credentials of the manufacturer and its subsidiary individually or together will be considered for compliance to the PQ criteria. In both cases parent organization shall stand guarantee for the quality of the end product, workmanship and performance of the plant. If the bidder is the subsidiary, necessary credentials shall be provided to substantiate.
- 1.2 The Bidder and its subsidiary, individually or together, shall have supplied and commissioned at least two De-inking Plants during the period after 1-1-2005 till date of the tender notice, with at least one plant for the production of De-inked pulp for LWC/writing and printing paper grades. The two plants referred shall be of production capacity of minimum 150 TPD De-inked pulp. The plant supplied earlier but commissioned after 1-1-2005 shall also be considered for compliance to this criteria.
- 1.3 The bidder shall also have executed upgradation of DIP, either for capacity or quality of at least one De-inking plant of capacity 100TPD during the above period. The upgradation shall involve addition/modification of Pulper, Flotation cell, Disk filter or Disperser. The plant under reference should have been commissioned successfully.
- 1.4 The Bidder shall have recorded an average annual turnover of INR.200Crore (US\$ 40 million) in the three preceding accounting years.

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- 2.1 The bid document can be downloaded from our web site/issued till 20-03-2012, based on a mail request to [projects@hnlonline.com](mailto:projects@hnlonline.com) upon remitting the cost of bid document by a Demand Draft/telegraphic/electronic transfer to our account. The cost of bid remitted will not be refunded. On remitting cost of bid document, HNL shall issue a Pre-Qualification Bid( PQ Bid,) initially. The bid document shall contain Pre-Qualification Criteria, basic technical/commercial details, HNL's plan & requirement, indicative Performance & Guarantee parameters etc. The bidders shall submit all relevant documents asked for to substantiate their reputation, experience and capacity for upgradation to satisfy the PQ criteria. Interested bidders shall submit their Offers against PQ Bid on or before the scheduled time fixed for submission. No EMD shall be submitted along with the PQ bid.
- 2.2 The offers against the PQ bid shall be prepared & submitted in the manner mentioned in the bid document, will be received till 14.00hrs. (IST) on 30-03-2012, which will be opened on the same day at 14.30 hrs (IST) in the presence of interested Bidders. If any bidder requires any clarification against the bid, they are requested either to visit the office of the undersigned at Newsprint Nagar or forward their queries by mail to [projects@hnlonline.com](mailto:projects@hnlonline.com).
- 2.3 The bids thus submitted will be evaluated based on the documents provided. Upon evaluation, Pre-Qualified Bidders will be allowed to participate in the next stage of tender & for the study of the existing plant for a maximum period of three days. After the study & discussion, the techno-commercial scope will be firmed up and the pre-qualified bidders will be required to submit their bids on a two-part basis (Part-1 & 11)against Revised Techno-Commercial document which will be issued free of cost.
- 2.4 HNL reserves its right, at its discretion, to issue an open global tender notice after firming up of the techno-commercial scope. If requires, HNL have the right to modify the revised techno-commercial scope before opening the price bid. Corrigenda, if any, to this Global Notice Inviting PQ Bid/ documents as well as to any of the subsequent Bid Document/s will be hosted in HNL website only.
