
**ORDER**

CA 761/2018 has been filed by the RP praying for extension of the CIR period by another 90 days. The 180 days shall expire on 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2018. However, keeping in view the stage and progress of the case, the COC envisages that the CIR process needs to be extended. The Resolution passed by the COC for directing the RP to seek extension is placed on record and has been voted by 100% in value of the claimants.

Accordingly, the applicant is allowed CIR period is extended by another 90 days.
